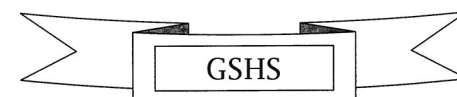

Complete one of the following:

- Earn a 1750 or higher on the SAT with a 530 minimum in each area
- Earn an ACT of 26 or higher composite score

Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
