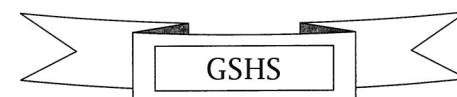

Complete one of the following:

- Earn 4 credits in 2 or more AP courses and take exams

- Earn a 1750 or higher on the SAT with a 530 minimum in each area
- Earn an ACT of 26 or higher composite score
